ON THE JOB TRAINING

Available to San Bernardino County Employers



Workplace-based learning where new employees acquire job related skills and knowledge while performing their regular duties, typically with mentorship and handson experience.



We offset the cost of training employees by reimbursing businesses 50% of wages once training is complete. Employees must be enrolled in the OJT Program prior to hire or promotion date and work at least 32 hours per week.

EXAMPLE

If a Trainee is paid \$25 hourly while receiving 480 hours of training, the business receives a 50% reimbursement, saving **\$6,000** in wages.
